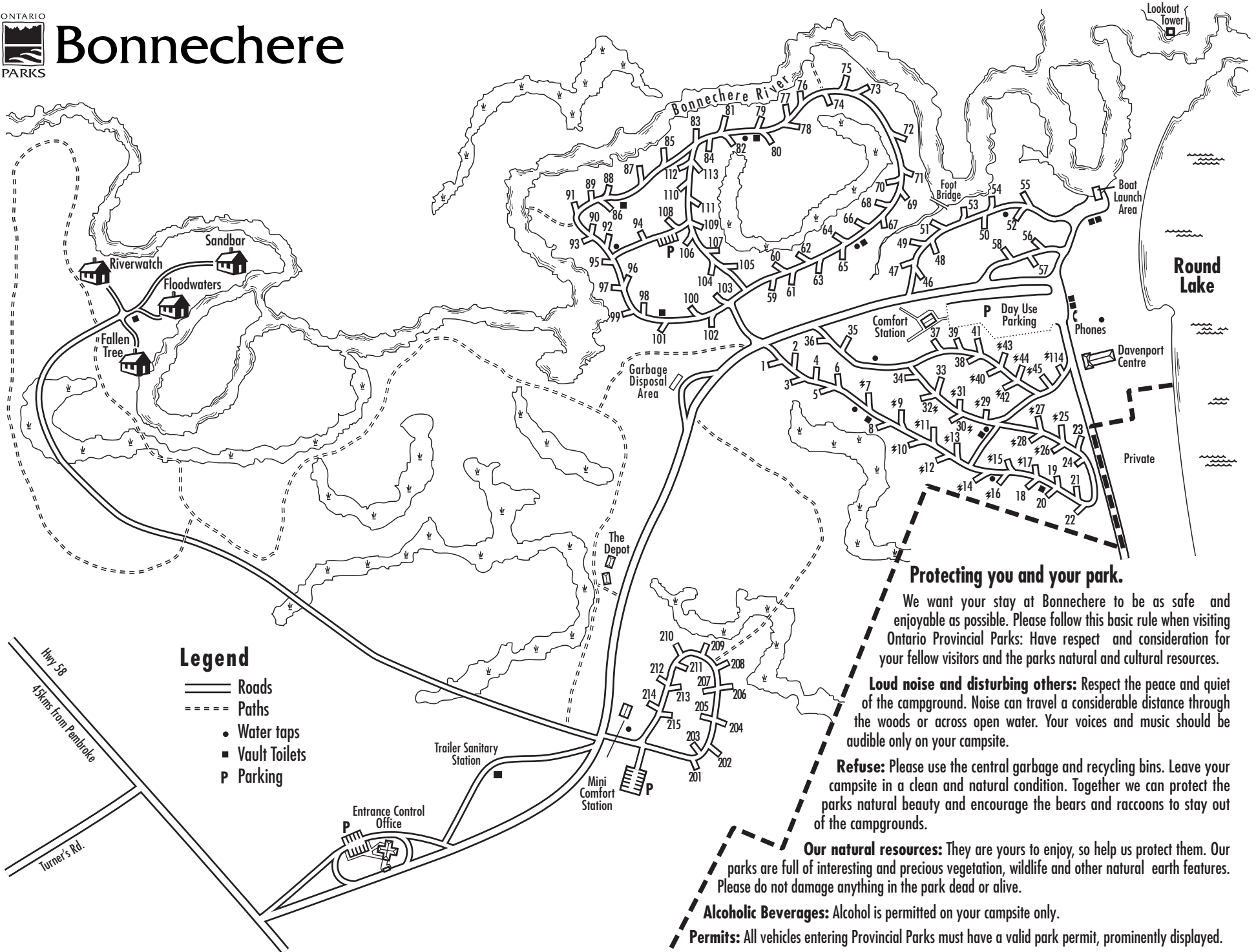


# Bonnechere

### Protecting you and your park.

We want your stay at Bonnechere to be as safe and enjoyable as possible. Please follow this basic rule when visiting Ontario Provincial Parks: Have respect and consideration for your fellow visitors and the parks natural and cultural resources.

**Loud noise and disturbing others:** Respect the peace and quiet of the campground. Noise can travel a considerable distance through the woods or across open water. Your voices and music should be audible only on your campsite.

**Refuse:** Please use the central garbage and recycling bins. Leave your campsite in a clean and natural condition. Together we can protect the parks natural beauty and encourage the bears and raccoons to stay out of the campgrounds.

**Our natural resources:** They are yours to enjoy, so help us protect them. Our parks are full of interesting and precious vegetation, wildlife and other natural earth features. Please do not damage anything in the park dead or alive.

**Alcoholic Beverages:** Alcohol is permitted on your campsite only.

**Permits:** All vehicles entering Provincial Parks must have a valid park permit, prominently displayed.
